

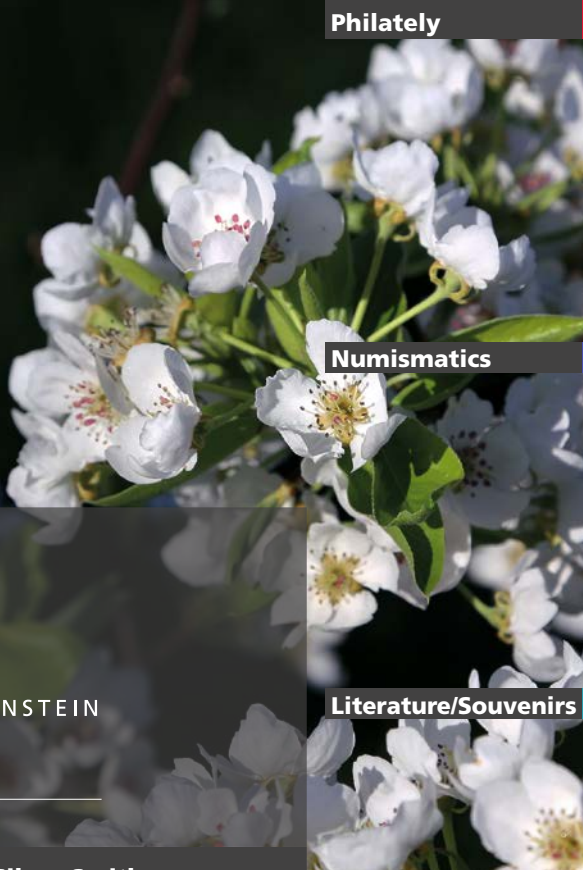

Information

The Philately is continuing the "Princely Treasures" series by presenting three items of German 17th century silver smithery. The "Sailing Boat" (face value: CHF 1.00) is a grand drinking vessel on four wheels with a drinking tube on its bow. Since the 14th century vessels of this kind served as a prestigious table requisite and were also used later during drinking games. The same applies to "Diana on a Stag" (face value: CHF 1.50), a masterpiece of gold smithery and a sophisticated item of the dining culture at court. Running gear in the base moved the drinks dispenser across the table. The guest seated where the drinking

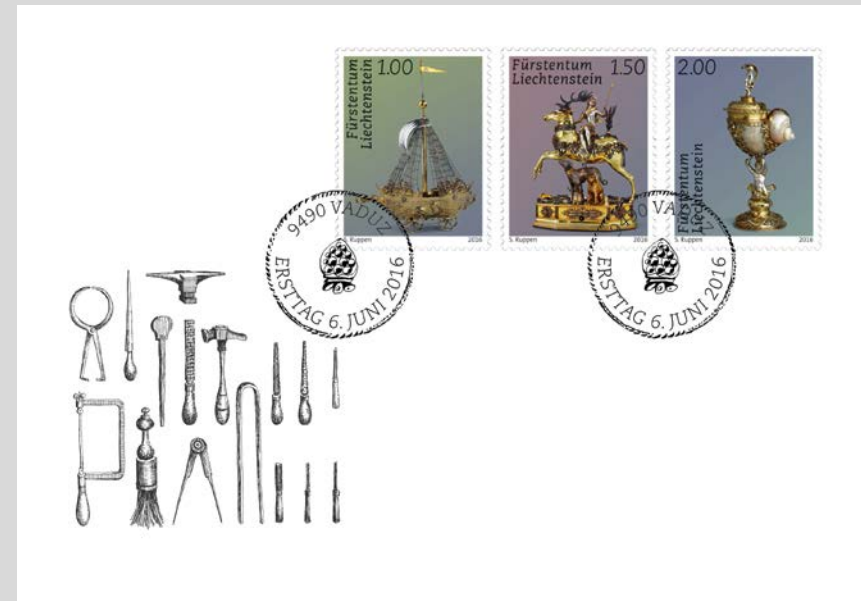
vessel came to a standstill had to drink out of it. The more the animal's belly emptied, the greater was the risk that the whole contents would be spilled over the person's face and clothing much to the amusement of the other guests. Animal housings also repeatedly served this handicraft as objects and were transformed into spectacular works of art by being mounted in special ways. The "Turbo Shell Cup" (face value: CHF 2.00) was made out of silver, partially gilded with gold and adorned with many artistic details. The special perforation and the elaborate print on silver foil literally make this issue shine.

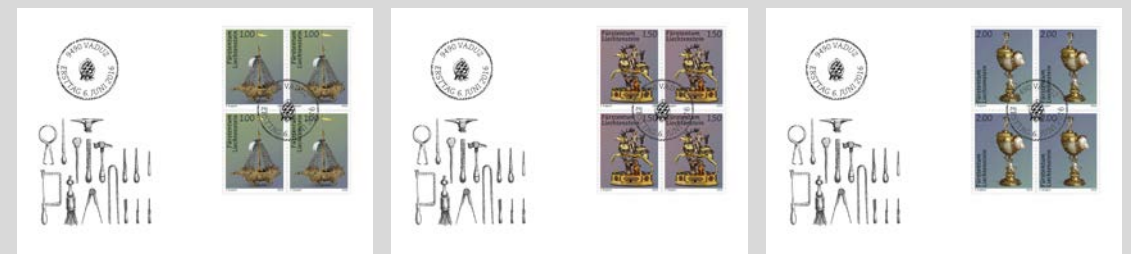

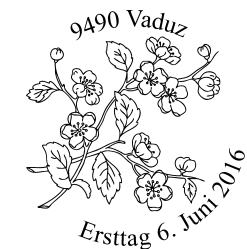
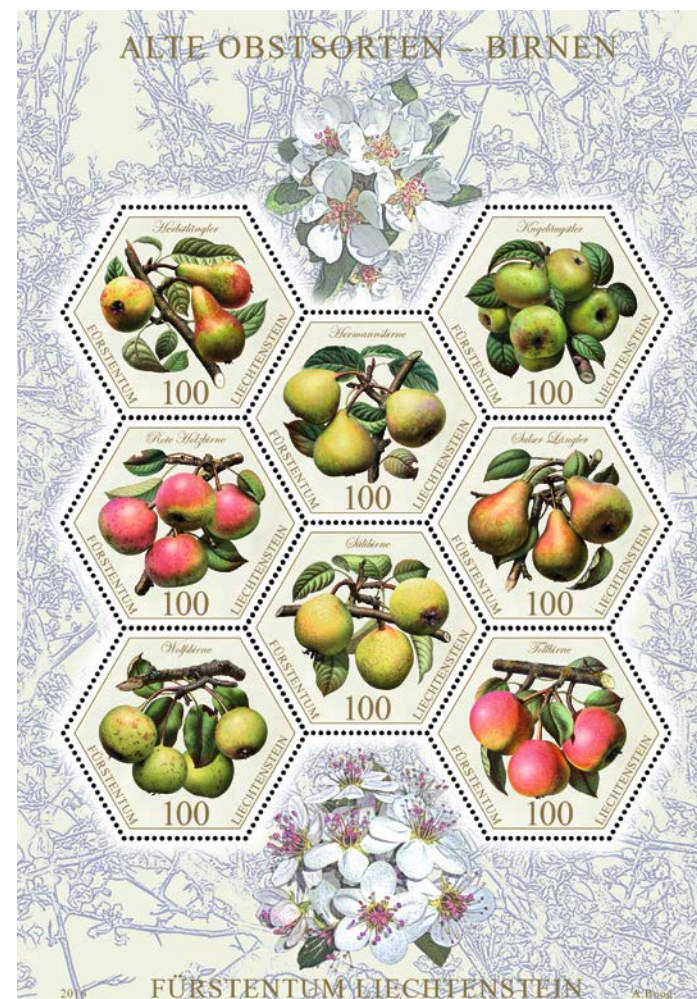

Eight se-tenant stamps printed on one sheet showing indigenous pears continue the stamp series of old fruit varieties. For this series, the scientific illustrator Angelo Boog depicts, accurate in every detail, the pear varieties Rote Holzbirne, Hermannsbirne, Herbstlängler, Sülibirne, Kugeläugstler, Wolfsbirne, Sulser Längler and Tollbirne (face value: CHF 1.00 each). Old, tall pear trees are impressive, characteristic features of the landscape. They produce high yields and are special eye-catchers when in blossom. Most pears are processed immediately after harvesting as many can only be stored for a short period. They are mainly

used for making cider and are mixed with apples. The Sülibirne pear is one of the varieties used as a cider pear. In addition to cider, other tasty products, such as brandy, can be made through distillation. While many varieties used to be mixed together, most distilleries today use distillates made of one variety only. Pears referred to as “Länglerbirnen”, such as the Herbstlängler, are typical of the region. These are ideal for drying, which people often used to do in their own ovens at home. Dried fruit is still used today for preparing traditional pear bread.

The special stamp series on nature reserves in Liechtenstein is being expanded to include two designs of the Ruggeller Riet. Dietmar Walser took a photo of meadow bathed in the orange glow of the rising sun. The photo of Xaver Roser shows a pond in the midst of a meadow reflecting the blue sky and white clouds. The two panoramic views of the "Meadow" and "Pond" were split down the middle to produce four stamps, each having a face value of CHF 1.00. Both designs are printed twice on an 8-stamp sheet. Spanning an area of around 90 hectares, the

Ruggeller Riet Nature Reserve is a peatland in the northernmost region of Liechtenstein. Its rich variety of fauna and, in particular, flora makes it a fascinating region for nature-lovers. Fens, ponds and litter meadows provide an ideal habitat for a host of endangered species and plants. One main attraction of the recreational area is the spectacular blossom of the Siberian Iris in May and June which covers large areas of the nature reserve in a carpet of magnificent blue. Altogether Liechtenstein has ten nature reserves covering a total area of 176 hectares.

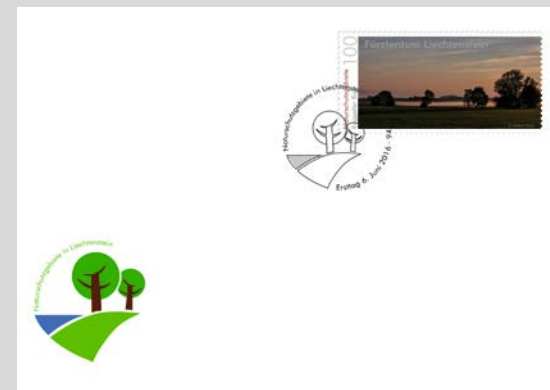
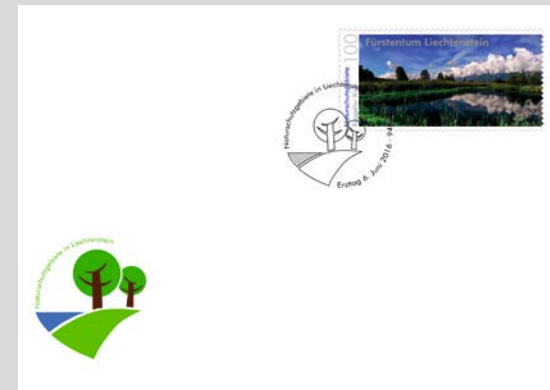
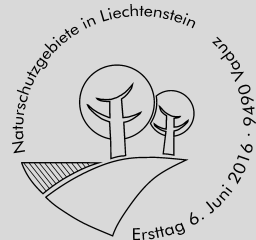

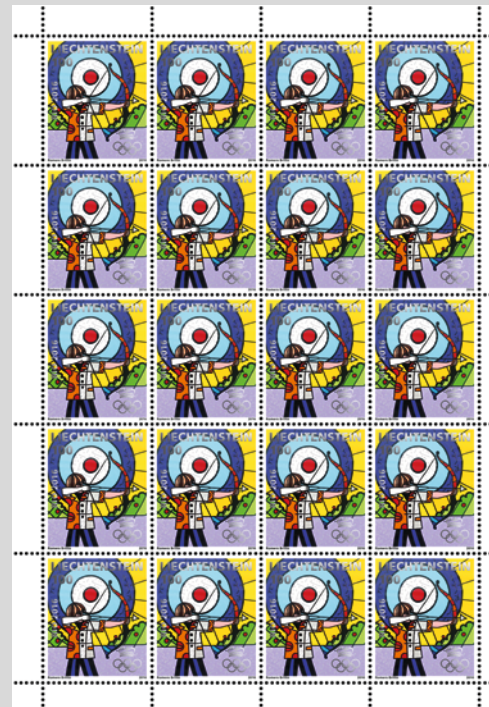
In keeping with tradition, Philately Liechtenstein will issue separate stamp series on the Olympic Games. An artist from the host country, Romero Britto, was engaged to design the special stamps on the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio.

Born in Recife, Brazil in 1963, Britto lived an extremely modest lifestyle while growing up amongst eight brothers and sisters. However, his innate creativity allowed Britto to fill his life with images of a bigger and more beautiful world beyond his own. After exhibiting in a few galleries and private shows, Britto

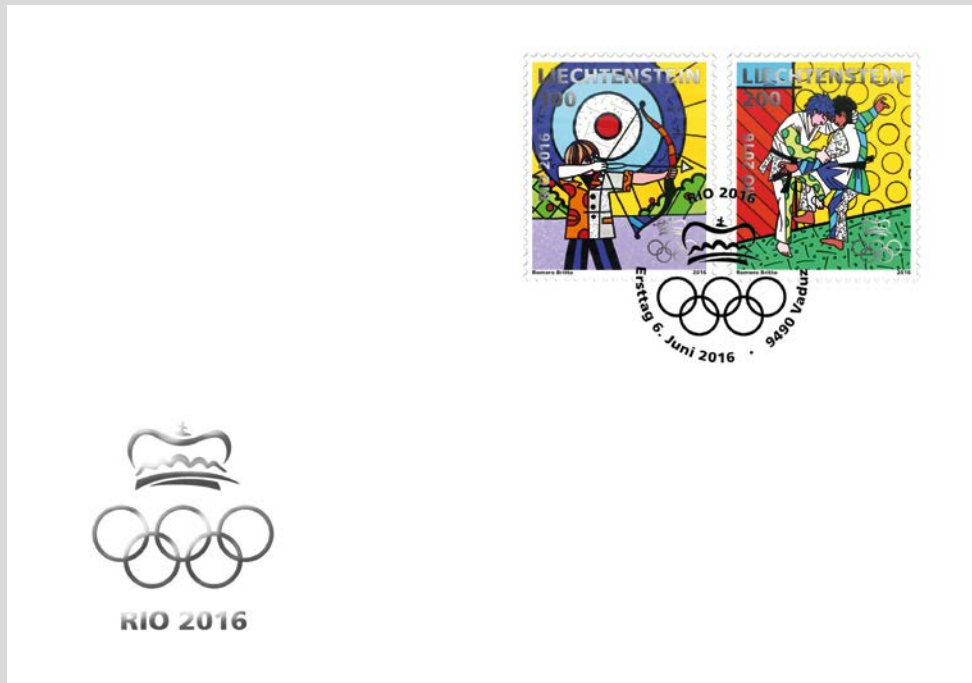
was encouraged to travel to the United States where Pop Art was flourishing. With an unshakable resolve and belief in his art, he spent the next few years exhibiting and attracting the attention of many. Romero Britto also designed the “Archery” (face value: CHF 1.00) and “Judo” (face value: CHF 2.00) special stamps in his distinctive style of pop art. These are two of the 28 types of sports in which over 10 500 athletes from 204 nations will put their performance to the test during the 17 days of the competition.

The method of "overprinting" is still used today in philately to make stamps or postal stationery with particularly attractive designs available with the nominal values currently in use. In order to continue using the attractive series of postal stationery from 2010 "Vaduz Castle in the four seasons II" after the latest price increases, the new face values CHF 1.50 and CHF 2.00 have been overprinted on the postcards "Autumn" and "Winter".

To celebrate the 60th anniversary of Europa stamps, PostEurop members are again issuing a joint issue with the same design for the first time since 2000 on the theme of "Ecology in Europe – Think Green" in 2016. The postal organisations of the four German-speaking countries Germany, Liechtenstein, Austria and Switzerland are issuing a joint special

folder on this occasion. It contains the four issues of the joint Europa stamp as well as one additional national issue on the same theme from Switzerland and from Liechtenstein. In addition to further information, the four postal organisations also provide insight into the action they have taken to ensure a resource-sparing and sustainable carriage of mail.
