At the end of July 2017, the royal couple in Liechtenstein, Hans-Adam II and Marie, will celebrate their golden wedding. To mark the occasion, an exclusive souvenir sheet with three stamps differing in size and value will appear: "Vaduz Castle" (value: CHF 1.30), "Royal Couple" (value: CHF 2.20) and "Crown" (value: CHF 2.80). The illustration by Angelo Boog was artistically depicted and underwent hot foil stamping in gold and silver, a pearlescent iriodin coating and multi-tiered embossing in a complex printing process.

The wedding of the then Hereditary Prince Hans-Adam II and Countess Marie-Aglaré Kinsky of

Wchinitz and Tettau on 30 July 1967 was a huge event never to be forgotten by the population of the small country. Thousands of people travelled to Vaduz, the capital, to take part in the celebrations. In addition to the service conducted by the bishop at the time, a bridal soir ee was held for invited guests at Vaduz Castle and a "Liechtenstein Evening" for the public. To round off the celebrations, there was a grand firework display. Since then, the family has grown considerably in size: the royal couple was blessed with four children who between them have produced fifteen grandchildren.

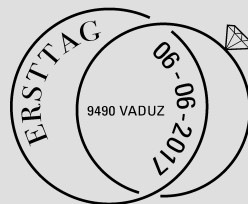

In addition to the normal version of the issue "Golden Wedding of Prince Hans-Adam II and Princess Marie of Liechtenstein", an unperforated special edition limited to only 1250 specimens and valid for postage will also appear. This is gilded with 22 carat genuine gold foil and embellished with a real ruby applied to the crown by hand. The block is numbered and supplied in a classy gold-foil case (incl. a certificate of authenticity for the 22 carat gold foil). The special edition costs CHF 250.00 (plus dispatch costs for registered post).

CHF 10 of the sales proceeds from each block of this special edition sold will be donated to the Liechtenstein Red Cross, which was founded in 1945 on the initiative of Her Serene Highness Princess Gina of Liechtenstein. Her Serene Highness Marie assumed the chairmanship from 1985 to 2015, when she handed the office over to her daughter-in-law Her Royal Highness Hereditary Princess Sophie.

To ensure that all those ordering this special edition have the same chance at receiving it, all the orders received will be collected until **22 May 2017** and then lots will be drawn for allocating it.

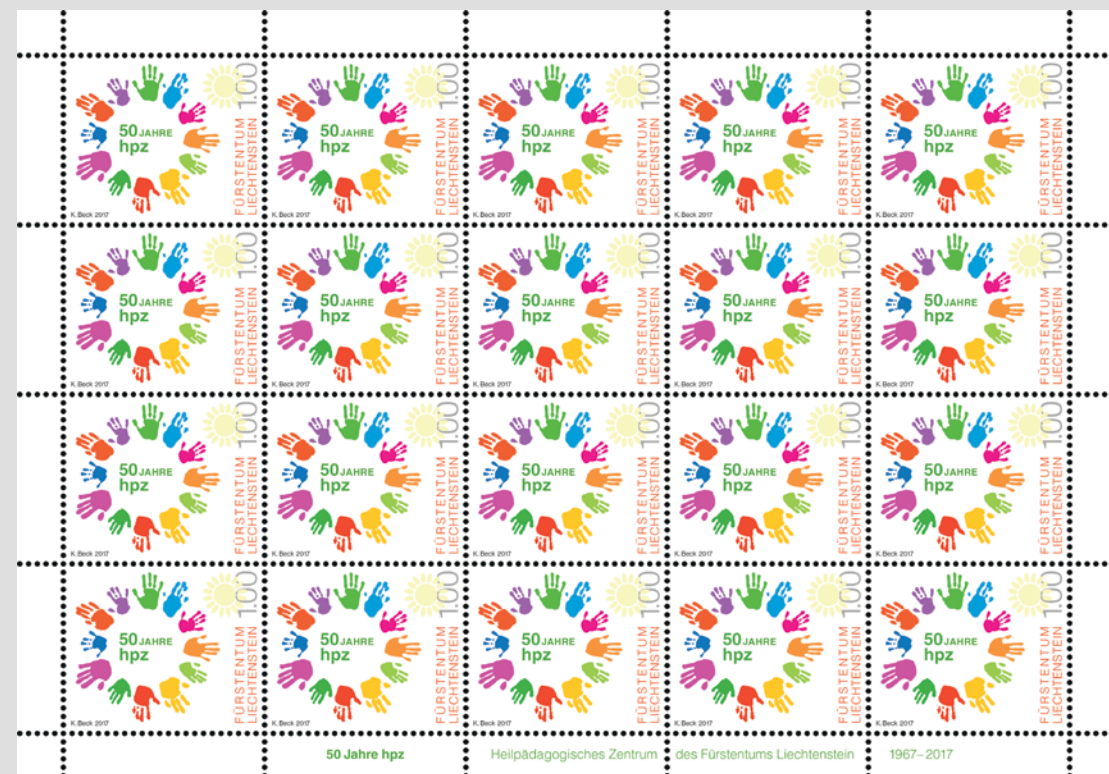
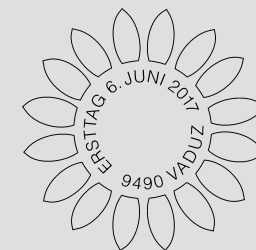
"Colourful Diversity" (value: CHF 1.00) is the name given to the special stamp to commemorate the 50<sup>th</sup> birthday of the HPZ Remedial Education Centre of the Principality of Liechtenstein which also accurately describes the nature of the organisation. The graphic artist Karin Beck arranged twelve handprints of children attending the HPZ school in bright colours so that they form a circle.

The HPZ Remedial Education Centre founded in 1967 by a sponsoring organisation under the presidency of Princess Gina and run today as a foundation is for people with special needs. The HPZ offers them

a school, a therapy centre, a place of work and for some, a home. In 1969, the institution's success story began when the special-needs school and special-needs kindergarten were opened. Shortly afterwards, a speech therapy service and the first workshops were set up. Over the decades, an increasing number of educational programmes and therapies became available and new occupational workshops and residential groups were added. The first residential group for children was opened in 2011. One year later the HPZ set a further significant milestone in the organisation's history by inaugurating its new schoolhouse.

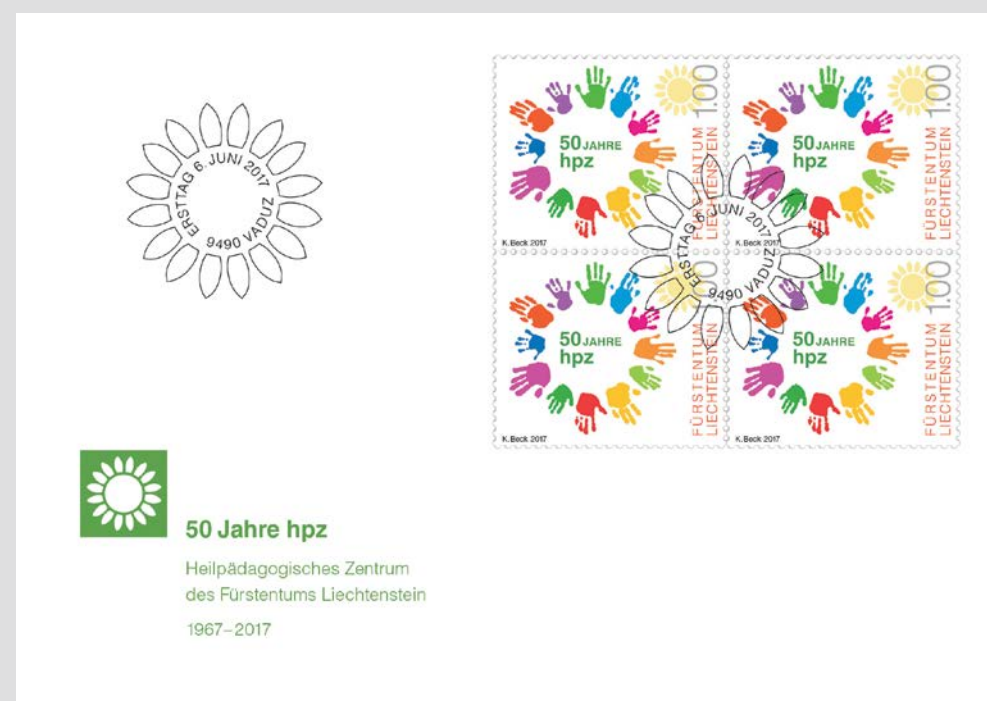

The Philately Liechtenstein is expanding its "Princely Treasures" series by adding three motifs from Viennese Biedermeier paintings. Austrian artist Peter Fendi (1796-1842) created the paintings "Request for Admission" (value: CHF 0.85), "Sneaking a Peak" (value: CHF 1.00) and "A Child's Prayer" (value: CHF 1.50), each of which appear on a miniature sheet consisting of eight stamps.

In 1833, the portrait and genre painter came to the court of Empress Carolina Augusta where he worked as an art teacher and painted children's portraits as well as watercolours. In the years afterwards he

became one of the most sought-after portraitists of Vienna's high nobility. Peter Fendi left behind a very extensive oeuvre. Among other things, he created over 2000 sheets with copies of antique works of art from the private and public collections in Vienna. He was also pioneering as a lithographer in his attempts to print his pictures in multiple colours.

The works eternalised on the stamps are items from the extensive art collections of the Prince of Liechtenstein. Since the beginning of the 17<sup>th</sup> century, the Princely Family of Liechtenstein has systematically supplemented its art collection and continues to successfully collect works of art still today.

With a surface area of 1.53 hectares, Lake Gampriner Seelein was created through extreme erosion, known as “scouring”, during a flood of the Rhine River in 1927. In 1961, the scenic spot was declared a protected area by the government. With its belt of silt and the surrounding gallery forest, the lake provides a habitat for valuable aquatic flora and for many birds and small animals.

Two panoramic photographs showing the lake from the same perspective – with the Kreuzberge mountains in the background – once in autumn and once in winter continue the series of special stamps on the

nature reserves in Liechtenstein. They are also the product of the photo competition held nationwide in cooperation with Fotoclub Spektral. The photograph of the winter scene was taken by Sepp Köppel, the one in autumn by Xaver Roser.

The two panoramic views were divided in the middle to create four stamps “Winter right”, “Winter left”, “Autumn right” and “Autumn left” (value: CHF 1.00 each). Both motifs are shown twice on a miniature sheet with eight stamps. The impressive views were framed in style with hot foil stamping in silver.

The cooperation between the postal administrations of European countries is a long-standing and well-tried tradition. The first joint "EUROPA" stamps appeared back in 1956. PostEuropa, a trade organisation that unites all the European public postal operators, has been responsible for coordinating Europa stamps since 1993 and has selected the topic of "Castles" for 2017. The co-production of this special folder continues the traditional multilateral cooperation

between the postal administrations of Switzerland, Austria, Liechtenstein and Germany. The special thing this year is that the postal administrations of Luxembourg and of the Netherlands are also taking part in the joint Europa product for the first time. Besides the stamps of the participating postal administrations, the "Castles" special folder includes interesting facts about the castles and palaces shown.

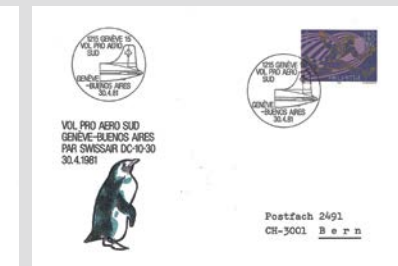

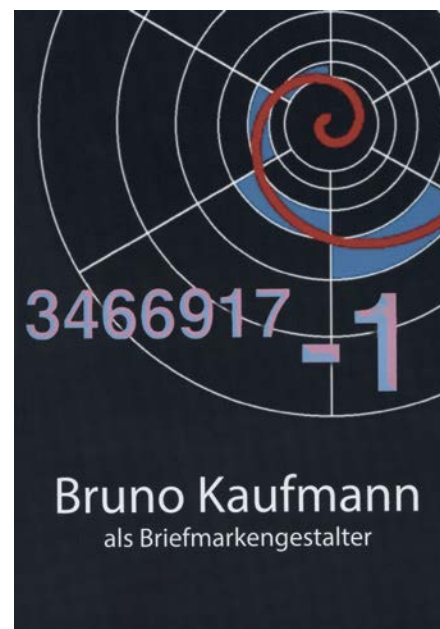

## Collections in Liechtenstein: No collector models to be made of motorcycles

For the five-part stamp series that has meanwhile ended entitled "Collections in Liechtenstein: Classic vehicles", high-quality collector models were made on a scale of 1:43 of the first four categories: "Veteran cars", "Sports and touring cars", "Saloon cars" and "Special-purpose and commercial vehicles".

As there was little demand for these collector models, Philately Liechtenstein is unfortunately forced to drop plans for the production of collector models for the last category "Motorcycles" for financial reasons. Philately Liechtenstein regrets this and hopes all the model collectors can understand this decision.

## Roland Seger is to become the new CEO of Liechtensteinische Post AG



The Board of Directors of Liechtensteinische Post AG has appointed the previous CFO Roland Seger to succeed the resigning CEO Peter Beck. Roland Seger, who is 45 years old, has worked at the company since May 2016 and officially took over the helm on 17 March 2017. Due to his various functions in internationally successful industrial companies Roland Seger has many years of manage-

ment experience. Since May 2016, he has also been a member of the management and in recent months has made a significant contribution to the continued stabilisation and future development of the company through his measures.

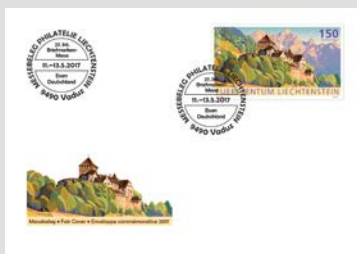
