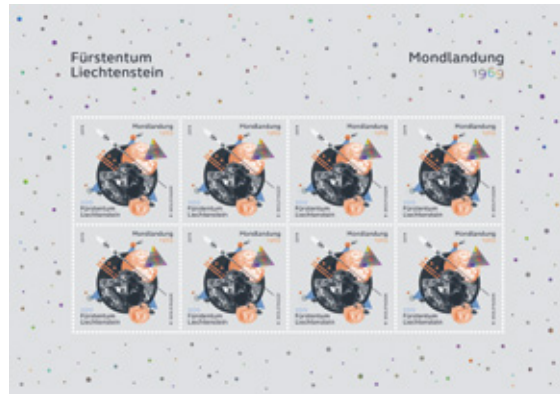
Fifty years ago, on 21 July 1969, two astronauts walked on the moon for the first time in human history. Philately Liechtenstein is issuing the two commemorative stamps "Astronaut" (face value: CHF 1.80) and "Lunar Lander" (face value: CHF 2.00) to mark the anniversary. Designer René Wolfinger created the two stamp motifs in black and white and colour using collages consisting of image and graphic elements.

of the Apollo 11 mission. The outward flight to the destination some 384,403 kilometers away lasted 76 hours which meant they reached moon's orbit on 19 July. While Collins remained behind in the command module of the spaceship, Armstrong and Aldrin landed the lunar module Eagle on the moon the next day. A few hours later Armstrong was the first human to walk on the moon, and shortly afterwards Aldrin as well. After a nearly 22-hour stay, the lunar module took off again from the surface of the moon and returned to the mother ship. Altogether twelve people – all US-Americans – have walked the moon, the last time in 1972.

Neil Armstrong, Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin and Michael Collins launched a Saturn V rocket from the Kennedy Space Center in Florida on 16 July 1969 as part

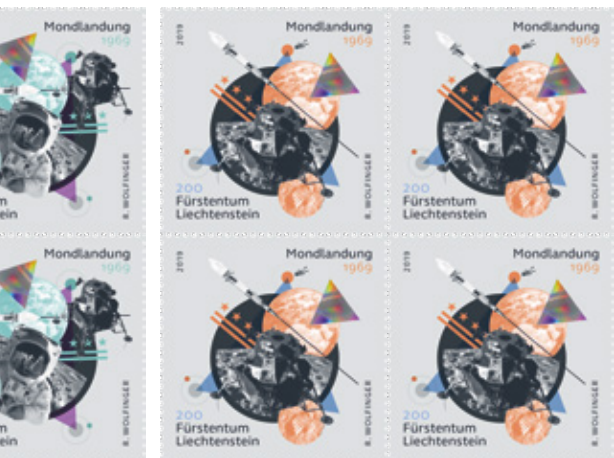

The 500th anniversary of the death of one of the most famous universal scholars of all time is being commemorated in 2019. The Italian Leonardo da Vinci went down in history as a painter, sculptor and architect as well as a mechanic, engineer, anatomist and natural philosopher.

The special block commemorating the anniversary of his death, consisting of three stamps with the drawings "Flying Machine" (face value: CHF 1.30), "Self-Portrait" (face value: CHF 2.20) and "Anatomic Studies" (face value: CHF 2.80), gives an idea of da Vinci's extensive and visionary work.

Even as a child, Leonardo liked to explore the laws of nature. His father sent him to the workshop of the Florentine sculptor and painter Andrea del Verrocchio for training. Da Vinci's numerous works of art, including paintings such as "Mona Lisa" and "The Last Supper", made him one of the leading artists of the Renaissance. But again and again he devoted himself to his other interests too: He dissected more than thirty corpses and made precise anatomical drawings of them. His passion for flying devices was not merely theoretical either. Among other things, he constructed a forerunner of the helicopter.

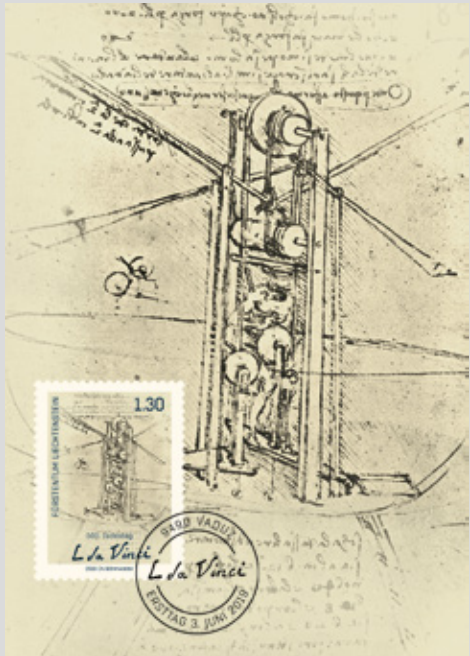

To mark the 300th anniversary of the Principality of Liechtenstein, Philately Liechtenstein is issuing the "Great National Coat of Arms" (face value: CHF 6.30) as a special stamp for the third time in history, in addition to the embroidered anniversary stamp that appeared in January. For the production of the six-colour special block, every possible step was taken in terms of printing technology: blind embossing, hot foil embossing in gold as well as UV varnishing and iridescent colours give the issue its exclusive look. The years 1719 and 2019 as well as all the coats of arms of the eleven municipalities of the country decorate the special block.

The grand national coat of arms is identical to the coat of arms of the Princely House of Liechtenstein and was introduced on 4 June 1957. The shield-shaped coat of arms contains six motifs on the origin and history of the noble family. One of them is the golden-red coat of arms of the House of Liechtenstein. It forms the heart shield. The other motifs refer to Silesia, the duchies of Troppau and Jägerndorf, the coat of arms of the Kuenringers and Prince Gundaker's first wife Agnes of East Frisia. The national coat of arms is encased by a princely mantle crowned with the princely hat.

Impressive mountain panoramas are replacing the popular series of special stamps on the nature reserves in Liechtenstein. The current motifs by Marco Nescher and Dietmar Walser also emerged as winners of the Fotoclub Spektral photo competition with many competitors. Like their predecessors, the two panoramic views were divided in the middle, creating four stamps. They currently show a "Mountain Summer" and a "Sunrise" (left and right, face value: CHF 1.00 each) and appear as a se-tenant on an eight-stamp sheetlet.

Liechtenstein is located fully within the Rätikon mountain range and has over 32 mountains with a height of at least 2,000 meters. Mountains cover about half of the national territory. The special "Mountain Summer" stamp focuses on the Falknis mountain range in the south of the country. It includes the Falknis (2,560 meters) as the western summit of the Rätikon as well as the Grauspitz, with 2,599 meters the highest mountain in Liechtenstein. The "Sunrise" photograph provides a fantastic view from Schönberg (2,104 meters) from where it is possible to see the surrounding mountain world particularly well.



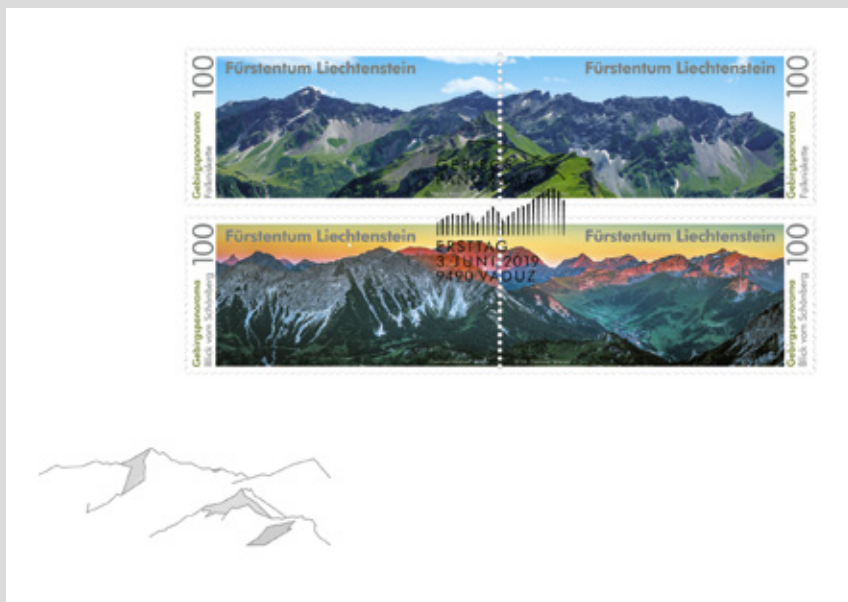

Pleasing business result for Liechtensteinische Post AG

Liechtensteinische Post AG can once again look back on a very successful financial year. Sales remained stable for the first time in a long while, with most of the business focus remaining unchanged. Costs were further reduced without limiting the range of services, resulting in a profit of CHF 3.04 million in the year under review, which even exceeded the positive result of the 2017 financial year.

Thanks to its positive business performance, Liechtensteinische Post AG was able to repay the loan from Swiss Post AG, which became necessary as a result of the external funding of the state pension fund, in full at the end of September 2018. Besides the complete payoff of the loan, there was a further increase in equity. The equity ratio of 55.8 % currently exceeds the target set in the investment strategy of the Princi-

pality of Liechtenstein. However, the absolute amount of equity has not yet reached the average level of the years prior to the restructuring of Liechtensteinische Post AG.

To meet these challenges of the future, a new strategy was adopted in 2018. The focus is now placed on activities with which a stable and expandable business basis can be created in the coming years. Liechtensteinische Post AG will use its "nationwide" daily contact with the population in and around Liechtenstein to expand existing services and launch new offerings as a reliable partner.

Presenting the anniversary stamp to the Prince Regnant

To mark the anniversary of “300 Years of the Principality of Liechtenstein”, Philately Liechtenstein issued an exclusive embroidered stamp in the shape of the Princely Hat for the first time in its history. In addition to this regular stamp issue, a limited special issue was released, embroidered with 24 carat real gold thread and adorned with eight original Swarovski crystals. This rarity, strictly limited to 2019 specimens, was completely sold out within a very short time.

Roland Seger, Managing Director of Liechtensteinische Post AG, and Stefan Erne, Head of the Philately Division, did not miss the opportunity of personally presenting a copy of the special issue to His Serene Highness Prince Hans-Adam II. The Prince Regnant was very pleased with this gift and praised the consistent innovative capacity of Philatelie Liechtenstein, which ensures that Liechtenstein enjoys a positive image worldwide due to its high-quality, creative stamps.
