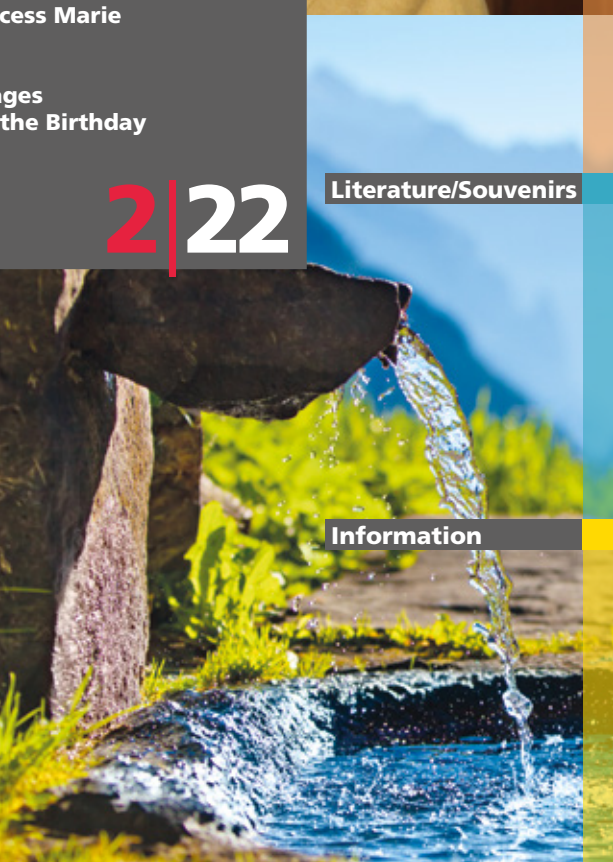
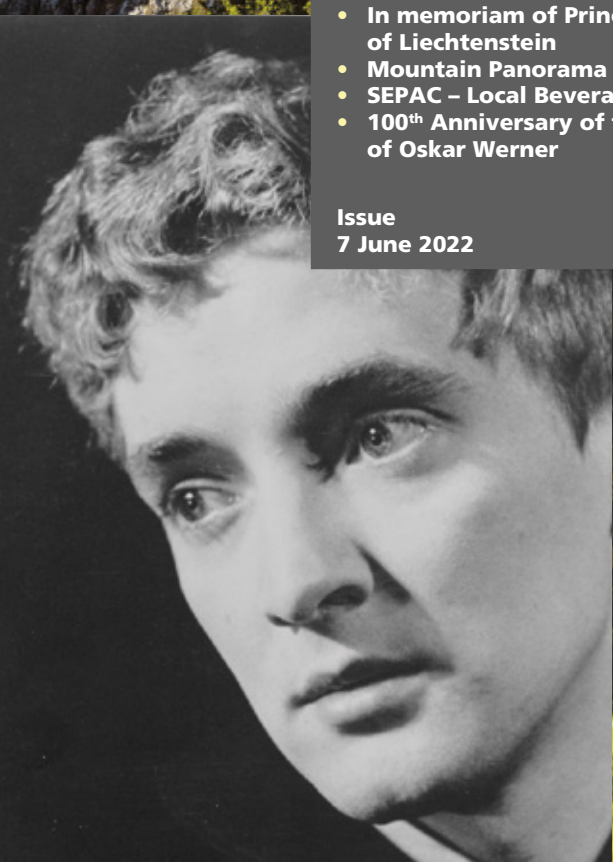

In August 2021, Liechtenstein bid farewell to its esteemed and beloved mother of the country. Princess Marie of Liechtenstein died aged 82 after suffering a stroke. Philately Liechtenstein now wishes to commemorate her life and work with a classy-looking souvenir sheet "H.S.H. Princess Marie" (face value: CHF 6.30).

children Alois, Maximilian, Constantin and Tatjana. After Hans-Adam II was appointed permanent deputy by his father Prince Franz Josef II in 1984 and entrusted with the administration of state affairs, the Princess henceforth performed representative duties at her husband's side.

After marrying the then Hereditary Prince Hans-Adam II in 1967, she devoted herself primarily to her family with their four

With her warm-heartedness and strong commitment to help people in need, she will go down in Liechtenstein's history as a revered mother of the country.

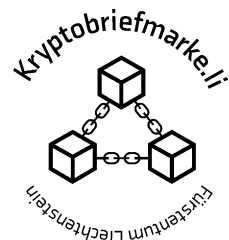

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

Breathtaking drone shots show previously unseen perspectives and fascinating views of the local alpine region on two new panorama special stamps. One of the motifs depicts the 1997-metre-high "Alpspitz" (left and right, face value: CHF 1.10 each) in the middle of the Rätikon mountain range. On the summit, Liechtenstein's oldest summit cross welcomes enthusiastic hikers and lovers of majestic views all year round. The Alpspitz is located on the Fürstesteig, Liechtenstein's best-known high-altitude hiking trail which was hewn into the rockface and opened in 1898. This is a much frequented hiking classic in summer. Alternatively, or in the colder season, you

can reach the Alpspitz summit on a hiking trail that takes you past the Alp Bargälla and over the Bargälla saddle.

The area around the "Drei Kapuziner" (left and right, face value: CHF 1.10 each) is also a popular hiking area in Liechtenstein. Seen from Alp Guschg, the rocky peaks of the mountain are reminiscent of monks from which it has its special name. Located to the southwest of the popular Schönberg and northwest of the Stachlerkopf, the 2084-metre-high mountain offers mountain hikers a fascinating panoramic view from Grisons to Lake Constance.

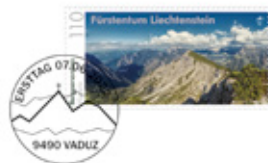




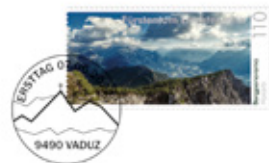

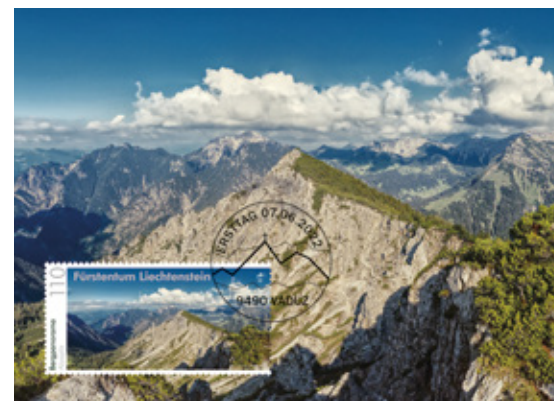

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

The stamp issue of SEPAC, an association comprising thirteen small postal operators in Europe, focuses this year on local beverages from its members' countries of origin. Philately Liechtenstein chose a thirst quencher that comes out of every tap and many public fountains in top quality in Liechtenstein: "Drinking Water" (face value: CHF 1.80).

Although unimaginable for most people in many parts of the world, people in the Alps enjoy drinking fresh water straight from the tap. Here, about half of the drinking water consumed each year is obtained from groundwater, the other half from spring water.

The strictest controls and continuous optimisation of the supply technology are intended to ensure a high standard of quality of the drinking water in the future as well.

Seven public water supply companies are responsible for this task. In order to ensure that the drinking water reaches the houses in top quality, they maintain numerous reservoirs and other structures such as transfer shafts in addition to the tapped springs and pumping stations. Almost 430 kilometres of main pipelines and 270 kilometres of service pipes are available for transporting the water.

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

Oskar Werner, the internationally successful Austrian actor, who lived in Liechtenstein during his lifetime, would have turned 100 this year. Three special stamps with illustrations of the artist born in Vienna in 1922 celebrate his life and career.

Oskar Werner was already acting while he was still at school. Roles as a bit player in film productions and his first speaking roles in radio, cabaret and theatre paved the way for his career at a young age. As "The Actor" (face value: CHF 0.90) with a charismatic voice, Oskar Werner was engaged to play numerous

film and theatre roles from 1938 to 1974. In 1952, "Oskar Werner" (face value: CHF 1.10) acquired a plot of land in the municipality of Triesen and built a house on it that enabled him to live a secluded life for many years. After his death from heart disease aged almost 62 "The Private Person" (face value: CHF 0.90) Oskar Werner was buried in Triesen in 1984. In 2011, his mortal remains were exhumed, cremated and his urn was buried in the southwest corner of the cemetery, where a plaque still commemorates him to this day.
