Information

Three special stamps of Philately Liechtenstein printed on a sheet of 16 stamps address the globally much discussed issue of migration. Designer Peter Vetsch shows one person each from the Arab, African and East Asian cultures on the stamps named "Hope" (value: CHF 0.85), "Departure" (value: CHF 1.00) and "New Beginning" (value: CHF 1.30). The colours selected symbolise the countries where the people come from while their face appears in the shape of the country of Liechtenstein, thus highlighting the Now.

From a historical viewpoint, the history of migration largely reflects Liechtenstein's economic history. Emigration in the 19th century was followed in the boom

phase of the economy after the Second World War by intensive immigration which has continued up to the present day.

According to statistics of 2014, the share of foreigners living in Liechtenstein came to 33.7 percent. In the reporting year, there were 615 immigrants in contrast to 476 emigrants. Just under two thirds of all the foreigners come from German-speaking countries, largely from the neighbouring countries of Switzerland and Austria. At just under 10 percent of the population, people from Italy and Turkey are the second largest group. The remaining 27.5 percent are people from countries around the world.



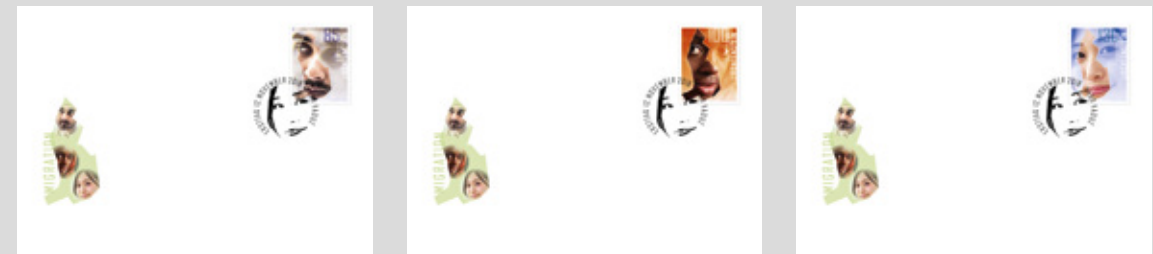

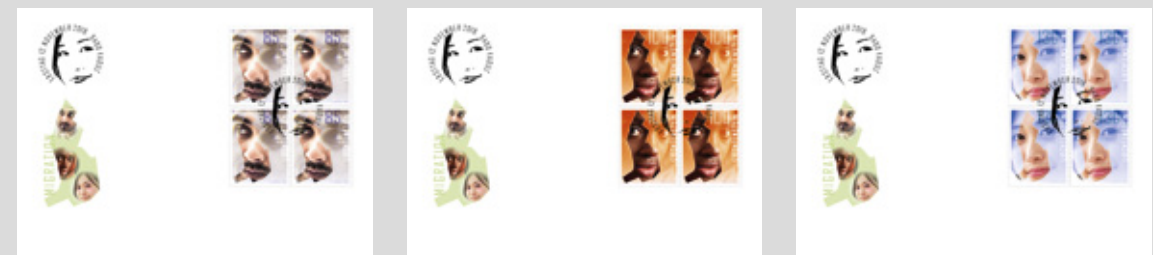

This year's Christmas stamps come from the winner of the second prize in a design competition hosted among Liechtenstein artists abroad. Manfred Näscher left his home country in 1996 and has been living and working in Berlin since 2008. In his design of the traditional Christmas story, he decided to depict four digitally produced scenes from the Christmas story resembling wood engraving.

were printed on a 20-stamp sheet. When the four stamps are placed side by side in increasing value, the colour progression becomes apparent.

The self-adhesive stamps "The Wise Men from the East" (value: CHF 0.85), "The Star Shows the Way" (value: CHF 1.00), "Peace on Earth" (Value: CHF 1.50) and "Birth of Jesus" (value: CHF 2.00)

According to the story, the legend of which began in the third century, Three Wise Men or Three Kings from the east followed a bright star to Bethlehem where they found baby Jesus. The names Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar commonly known in western churches were mentioned in legends in the sixth century for the first time.

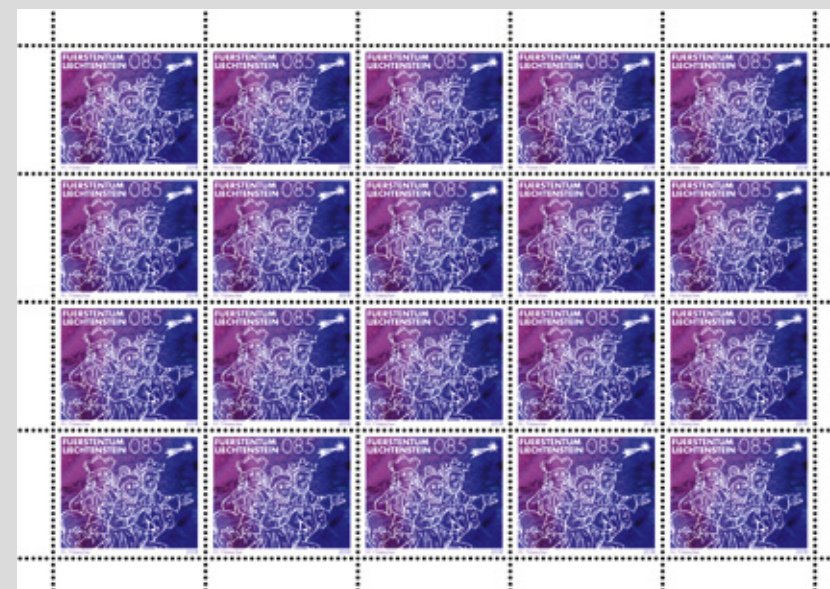

The Philately is continuing its elaborately designed series of Chinese signs of the zodiac with this issue. For the "Year of the Pig 2019" (value: CHF 2.00), it is issuing a self-adhesive special stamp designed in the form of a delicate paper cut and produced using ultramodern laser technology. The sheet of four stamps in red, a colour that symbolises luck in China, is also cut in the shape of a pig. All overprints were affixed in high-grade gold foil embossing.

The next Chinese year begins on 5 February 2019. According to astrologers from the Far East, 2019 will

be a year of good fortune. It will be an excellent year to earn money and will also be a year of friendship and love for all signs of the zodiac. Experts state that those born in the year of the pig are by nature peace-loving, trusting, honest and sincere. They are said to have good luck and success in business and science and when handling money. They are also supposed to have a thirst for knowledge and are generally well-informed. The pig specially celebrated in 2019 is also very patient, practically-minded and has both feet firmly on the ground.
