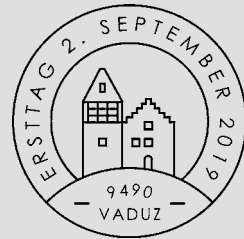
Sepac is a co-operation of thirteen small postal administrations in Europe and issues stamps on common themes every year. Liechtenstein's contribution to the topic of "Old Residential Buildings" is a special stamp in steel engraving showing the "Red House" (face value: CHF 1.50) in Vaduz from a lesser known perspective.

In its present appearance, the Red House was built between 1902 and 1905, when sculptor and architect Egon Rheinberger connected the much older residential building with a stepped gable and the old wine press building with a round tower built

according to his own plans. He thus created a striking architectural complex, which today, alongside Vaduz Castle, is another landmark of the capital and has been a listed building since 1951. The history of the building's construction is not clearly documented. However, archaeological findings have shown that work began on another construction on the same site before being abandoned in the 15th century at the latest. The ownership of the Red House has been documented since the beginning of the 16th century. After belonging to a monastery for almost 300 years, it passed to the Rheinberger family from Vaduz in 1807, whose descendants still live there today.

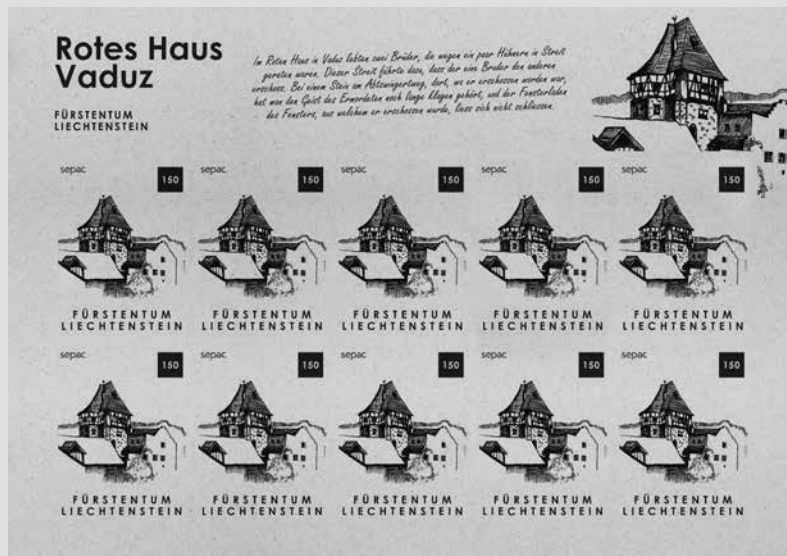

A special block with three stamps is dedicated to the first circumnavigation of the world 500 years ago. The Portuguese "Ferdinand Magellan" (face value: CHF 2.80) set sail from Spain in 1519 with five ships and a crew of 237 men with the aim of finding a western sea route to the Moluccas Islands in Southeast Asia. Spices grew there that were much sought-after and traded at high prices in Europe. Magellan headed for South America first, where he found the entrance to the Pacific between Tierra del Fuego and the southern tip of South America in October 1520. The strait known as the "Magellan Strait" was an important sea route until the construc-

tion of the Panama Canal and is still used by many ships today. In the following March, the fleet reached an island in the Philippines but Magellan was killed in a dispute with the indigenous people. The stamp "Death in the Philippines" (face value: CHF 2.20) commemorates this bloody battle. The Spaniard Juan Sebastian Elcano became the new captain. He succeeded in reaching the Spice Islands. He then sailed with the "Victoria" (face value: CHF 1.30) around the southern tip of Africa back to Spain, arriving on 7 September 1522 on the only sailing ship left in the fleet, loaded with precious spices, thus completing the circumnavigation of the world.

With bronze sculptures from the collections of the Prince of Liechtenstein, Philately Liechtenstein is continuing its popular multi-part series "Princely Treasures". The three objects by Italian sculptor Pier Jacopo Alari-Bonacolsi (c. 1455 to 1528) each fit on a miniature sheet of nine stamps. The artist, known by his nickname Antico, saw his life's work as being the revival and preservation of the sculptural art of antiquity. He recreated the compositions of famous classical statues in numerous exceptionally detailed works. The "Bust of a Young Man" (face value: CHF 1.40) is a

bronze figure about 56 centimetres high, which Antico created in around 1520, two distinct characteristics of which are the oil gilding and the silver inlay for the white of the young man's eyes. "Hercules with a Lion's Skin" (face value: CHF 1.70) was created in around 1500 and represents the Greek hero known for his strength in a partially gilded, approx. 35 centimetre high statuette. Only slightly larger is the "Equestrian Statue of Marc Aurel" (face value: CHF 2.20), the fire-gilded parts of which highlight the rider's hair and coat.

A new series with village views depicting all the local communities of the Liechtenstein Oberland begins with the community of Triesen. The stamp "Old Village Centre" (face value: CHF 2.00) shows the community with around 5,200 inhabitants embedded in a typical Liechtenstein landscape between the mountains and the Rhine. The view is directed southwards from the higher part of the village St. Mamertha. The second stamp focuses on the "Lady Chapel Triesen" (face value: CHF 1.30). It was first mentioned in writing in 1415 as the "Chapel of the Virgin Mary in the Village of Triesen". In 1654, the sacred building was extended to include just one wall of the initial

late Romanesque building. More recently, in 1964 and in 2002, the chapel underwent two extensive renovations.

Graphic artist Karin Beck decided on a high-contrast design for the new stamps: While the photographs of the actual view of the village and the buildings are kept in black and white, the landscape in the background serves as a colour-graduated backdrop, giving the landscape the desired depth effect.
