Information

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

Painter, graphic artist and photographer known by the name of Eugen Zotow in Liechtenstein, originally came from today's Ukraine, which gained state sovereignty in 1991 after the dissolution of the Soviet Union. Born Ivan Miassojedoff in Kharkiv in 1881, he attended his father's painting school in Poltava, a city in central Ukraine, before moving to Moscow and St. Petersburg for academic studies in painting.

The impact of the First World War and the Russian Revolution caused his life plans to fail and prompted him to leave his homeland. The Crimean peninsula was his last stop on home soil in 1919. His path to exile took him and his small family via stops in several other places to Berlin and finally to Liechtenstein in 1938. As an exile, he was only allowed to earn his living by practising art, according to an order of the

Liechtenstein government. Until his death in 1953, he created numerous works of art and also designed twelve Liechtenstein postage stamps.

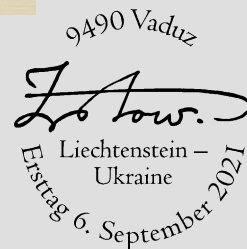
Now two special stamps are being dedicated to him as part of a joint issue with Ukraine: Philately Liechtenstein chose the motif "View of Vaduz Castle" (face value: CHF 1.40) from the collection of Prof. Eugen Zotow-Ivan Miassojedoff-Stiftung, Vaduz, while the Ukrainian Post (Ukrposhta) opted for a "Self-portrait" (face value: CHF 2.20) from Poltava Art Museum.

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

"Freedom" (face value: CHF 0.85), "Peace" (face value: CHF 1.00) and "Democracy" (face value: CHF 1.50) are the three special stamps issued by Philately Liechtenstein to mark the 100th anniversary of the Constitution of the Principality of Liechtenstein. In high-quality metallic printing and foil stamping, they have a modern and forward-looking design, but also build a bridge to the past as they show an excerpt from the original edition of the Constitution of 1921.

The emergence of political parties in Liechtenstein after 1914 brought with it the call for a reform of the monarchical state. Especially after the collapse of

the monarchy in Germany and Austria and what was known as the Liechtenstein November coup d'état in 1918, the monarchical idea of the state in the form of the constitution of 1862 was no longer viable.

During negotiations in September 1920, the forces of reform agreed with representatives of Prince Johann II on what were known as the Castle Agreements that created a basis for a draft constitution. The new constitution of 1921 finally defined the principality as a constitutional hereditary monarchy on a democratic and parliamentary basis with the powers of the state resting with the Prince and the people.

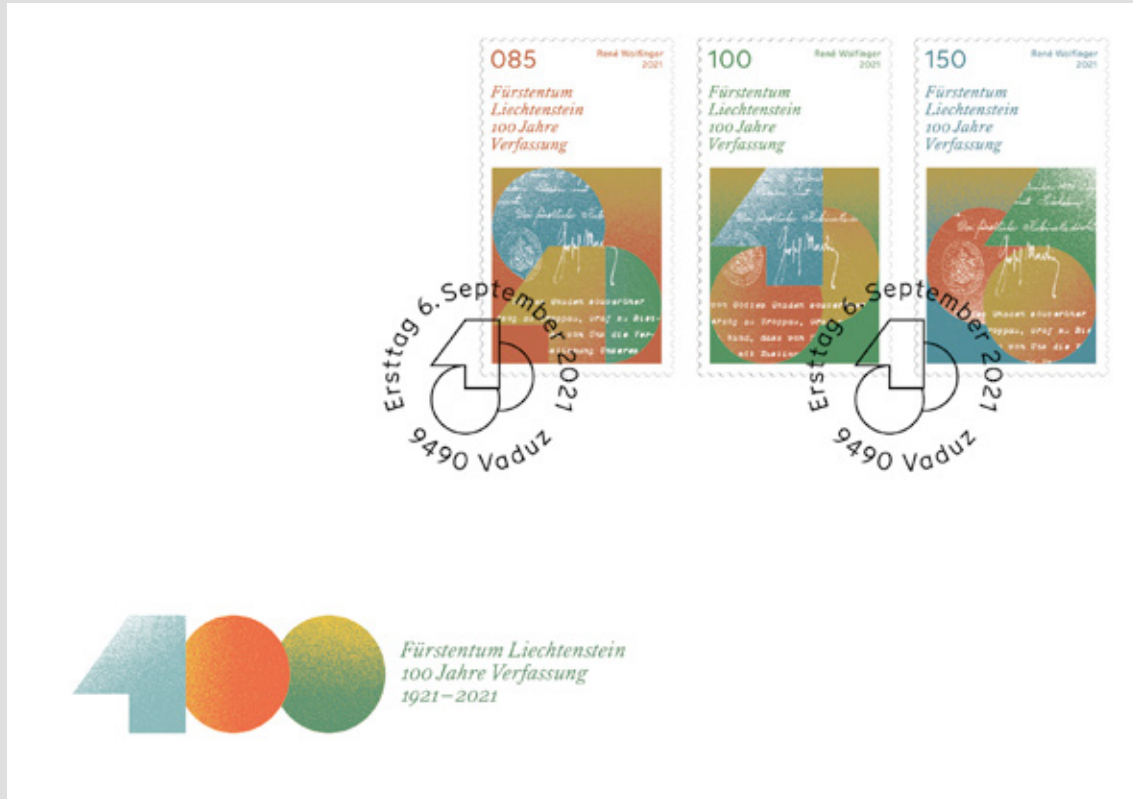

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

In 1971, Ray Tomlinson from the firm BBN was working with other members of staff to set up a data transmission system for the United States Department of Defence. Whilst doing so, he discovered a way of sending a file from one computer to a user on another computer. The recipient was able to read the file, save it, change it and send it back again.

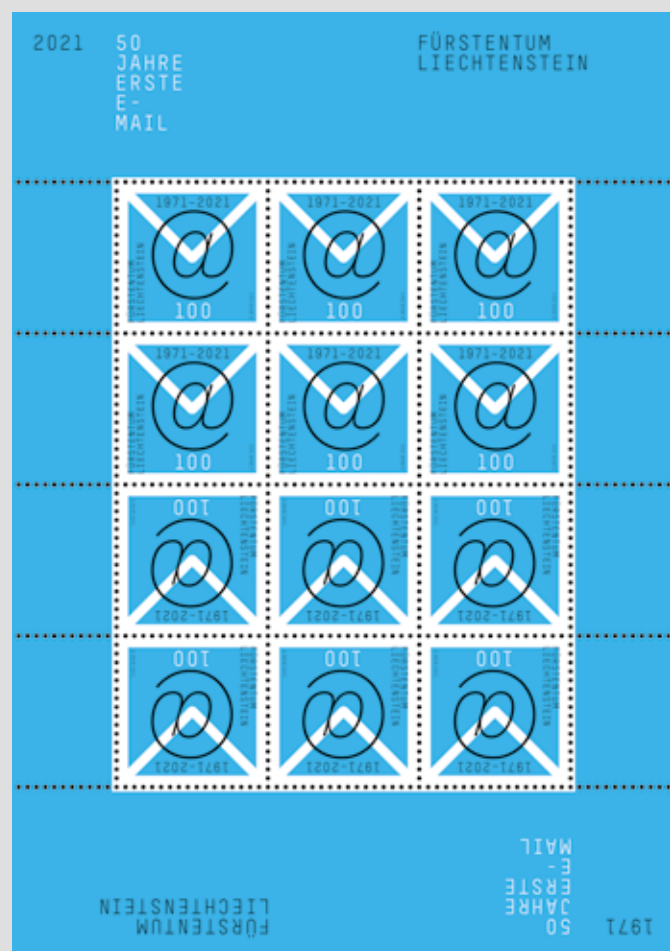
Although not part of Tomlinson's actual assignment, this created the idea of the e-mail. For transmission, it was necessary to combine the addressee and the computer name in the file address. Since this was not possible with a normal character because of the

danger of confusion, a special character had to be found. Tomlinson decided to use the @, which he discovered in a special character set on his mainframe computer.

E-mails have long since become the dominant means of communication in the business world and the special character @ now has its permanent place on every keyboard. The special stamp "50 Years of the First E-mail" (face value: CHF 1.00) by Cologne-based designer Detlef Behr also features the at symbol. The stamp is available in a sheet of 12 wet-adhesive stamps.



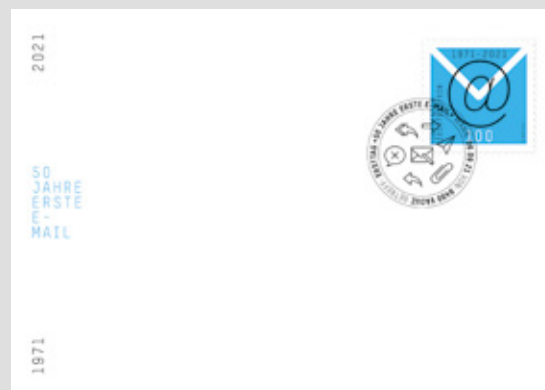

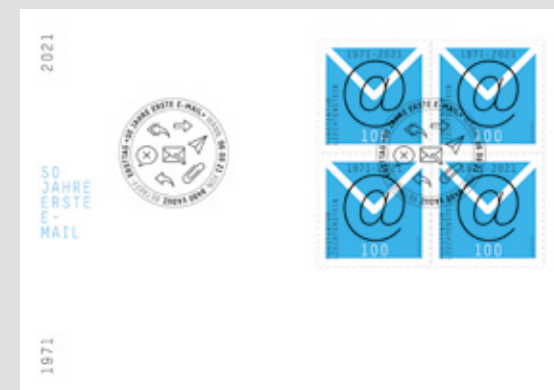

700th Anniversary of the Death of Dante Alighieri

Official stamp issue of the Principality of Liechtenstein

An artistically designed souvenir sheet with two stamps commemorates the 700th anniversary of the death of the Italian writer Dante Alighieri. Designer Thomas Giger created pen and ink drawings for the issue, the characteristics of which are particularly accentuated in the steel engraving. In addition to the special stamps "Portrait of Dante Alighieri" (face value: CHF 3.70) and "Writing Hand with Quill" (face value: CHF 4.00), the image on the souvenir sheet is based on a scene from Dante's main work Divina Commedia (The Divine Comedy).

Little is known about the childhood and adolescence of the greatest Italian writer of the Middle Ages. It is considered certain that he was born around 1265 in Florence and received education and encouragement at a young age. From the age of thirty, he held various political offices. However, in the struggle for the independence of Florence against the attempts of Pope Boniface VIII to intervene, he became entangled in an unsuccessful opposition and was subsequently condemned to perpetual exile from Florence and shortly afterwards sentenced to death. From 1303 he led a vagrant life, which took him to Ravenna in the years preceding his death in 1321.
