



Conditions of participation

Anniversary competition 'Crypto Circus'

The competition is organised by **Philately Liechtenstein**, Alte Zollstrasse 11, 9494 Schaan, Principality of Liechtenstein. All natural persons aged 18 and over are eligible to participate.

There are two ways to enter the competition:

a) Automatic entry through purchase By purchasing a crypto stamp from the 'Crypto Circus' issue, you will automatically be entered into the competition. Each crypto stamp contains an individual ticket number. Each ticket number therefore counts as a separate chance to win.

b) Free participation without purchase Participation is also possible without purchase. To do so, the official entry form must be completed in full and returned by post to Philatelie Liechtenstein **by 31 March 2026 (date of postmark)** at the latest. One free entry per person is possible.

The following prizes will be raffled off among all valid ticket numbers: 1× rainbow crypto stamp, 2× purple crypto stamps, 3× green crypto stamps, 4× blue crypto stamps and 10× red crypto stamps. Cash payment of the prizes is excluded.

The competition runs until 23:59 on 31 March 2026. The date of purchase or, in the case of free participation, the date of the postmark is decisive. The winners will be determined at random from all valid ticket numbers after the competition has ended. The winning numbers will be published in the Philatelie Liechtenstein online shop and in the newsletter.

If you win, **the detachable ticket strip with the corresponding ticket number must be sent to Philatelie Liechtenstein by 30 April 2026** at the latest. The date of receipt by post is decisive. After this deadline, the claim to the prize expires. Legal recourse is excluded. Liechtenstein law applies. The personal data collected as part of the competition will be used exclusively for the purpose of conducting the competition and will be treated in accordance with the applicable data protection regulations.
